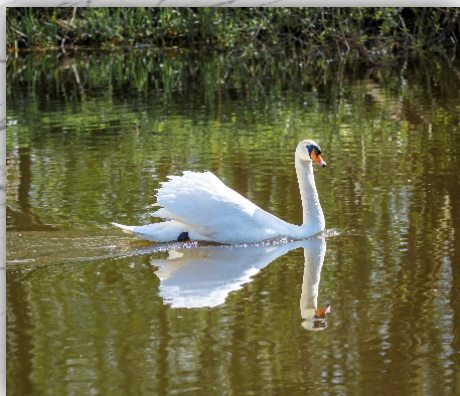


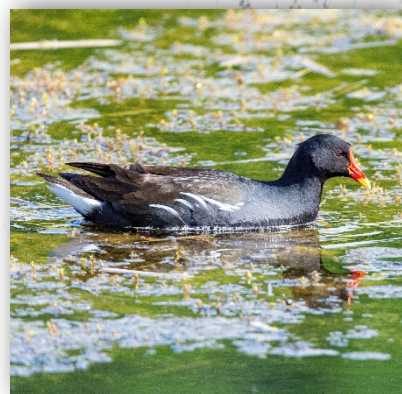

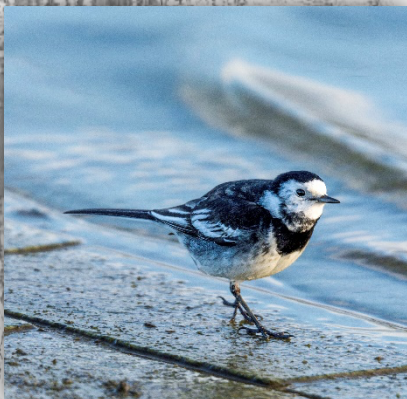

This activity sheet was produced by the Friends of Avon Meadows, a registered charity. The Avon Meadows wetland was established in 2008 jointly by Pershore Town Council and Wychavon District Council. It comprises an area of 24 hectares beside the River Avon, only a 5-minute walk from the town centre. Originally water meadows, a series of flooded scrapes have been created as a haven for wildlife. There are numerous footpaths in the area and a boardwalk runs through the middle of the wetland so that visitors can get closer to the wildlife.
